ALTSA: AFH #2016-004 CR-103 FILED AMENDING CHAPTER 388-76 WAC

Dear Adult Family Home Provider:

The Department has filed a final Rule-Making Order (CR-103) to amend sections of Chapter 388-76 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC). These changes are needed to be in compliance with newly passed legislation, Substitute House Bill 1132 and to address resident safety concerns.

A CR-103 (WSR 16-01-171) was recently filed with the Office of the Code Reviser to complete the rulemaking process. These rules will become effective January 22, 2016. Highlights of the changes include:

- A one-time waiver of the adult family home application fee under exceptional circumstances such as the death of a co-provider.
- Clarification about primary egress doors and required hardware. Although WAC 388-7610715 (3) does not specify, the designated egress door hardware only applies to homes
 licensed after January 1, 2016. However, for the homes in which this does not apply,
 providers should ensure residents can evacuate the home without special knowledge or
 effort.
- Clarification about how much notice must be given when services increase or decrease.
