ALTSA: AFH #2020-009 **CR-101 FILED TO PROPOSE ADDING AND AMENDING SECTIONS** OF CHAPTER 388-76 WAC (AFH MINIMUM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS)

The department is considering adding and amending sections of Chapter 388-76 of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) for Adult Family Home Minimum Licensing Requirements. These changes are needed to benefit and support the entities regulated by this Chapter and implement legislation passed in the 2020 legislative session.
