ALTSA: AFH #2020-031 CR-101 FILED TO CONSIDER AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 388-76 WAC (ADULT FAMILY HOME MINIMUM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS)

The department is considering amending sections of Chapter 388-76 WAC, Adult Family Home Minimum Licensing Requirements. These changes are needed to update the rules and make them easier to implement and enforce.
