ALTSA: ALF 2015-015 CHARACTER, COMPETENCY, AND SUITABILITY (CCS) DETERMINATION FORM

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator and Interested Parties:

This is to provide notification that a new tool is now available for you to record character, competency, and suitability (CCS) reviews related to background checks with nondisqualifying information that appear on the results in accordance with <u>WAC 388-78A-2461</u> <u>- Background Checks-General</u>. A link to the CCS Determination Form (DSHS 15-456) is available on the ALTSA website at <u>https://www.dshs.wa.gov/altsa/residential-care-services</u>.

A CCS determination is required whenever an individual has the following that appear on a background check result that is <u>non-disqualifying</u>: convictions(s), pending charge(s), and/or negative action(s). In addition, a CCS may be completed when there are concerns about an individual related to the health and safety or other risk to the resident.

The CCS form includes instructions assist you in completing each section of the form. Documentation received from the applicant/employee, the Background Check Central Unit (BCCU), the Department of Health source information at the following website <u>https://fortress.wa.gov/doh/providercredentialsearch/SearchCriteria.aspx</u>, the signed disclosure statement from the applicant, plus any other additional resources can be attached to this form.

A CCS determination <u>cannot</u> be used when the applicant/employee has <u>automatically</u> <u>disqualifying</u> convictions, pending charges or negative actions. The use of this form is <u>not</u> mandated by RCS regulations.
