**CR-101 FILED TO PROPOSE ADDING & AMENDING SECTIONS**  
**TO CHAPTER 388-78A WAC**

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator:

The department is considering adding, repealing, or amending sections to Chapter 388-78A of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) for Assisted Living Facility Licensing Rules. The CR-101 document was recently filed with the Office of the Code Reviser.

The department's purpose in filing the CR-101 is to add, appeal or amend sections to Chapter 388-78A WAC.

- The rule making will be limited to the management agreement sections and the associated definitions.
