ALTSA: ALF #2019-007 CR-101 RE-FILED TO PROPOSE ADDING & AMENDING SECTIONS **TO CHAPTER 388-78A WAC**

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator:

The department is considering adding, repealing, or amending sections to Chapter 388-78A of the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) for Assisted Living Facility Licensing Rules. A CR-101 for this rule development was filed previously under WSR #16-20-023. Due to the age of the public notification, this Preproposal Statement of Inquiry has been refiled under WSR #19-08-001. There has been a considerable amount of stakeholder work completed to date. This will be a continuance of the current stakeholder workgroup.

The department's purpose in filing the CR-101 is to add, appeal or amend sections to Chapter 388-78A WAC.

- These rules have not been updated in seven or more years and are unclear, ambiguous, and inaccurate.
- These rule changes will create consistent regulations across the Residential Care Services programs.
- The rule making will be limited to the physical plant sections and the associated definitions.
