## ALTSA: ALF #2020-022 EMERGENCY RULES SUSPENDING REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMINISTRATOR TRAINING CERTIFICATES

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator:

The Department of Social and Health Services filed <u>emergency rules</u> effective April 23, 2020 to suspend requirements related to administrator training certificates in WACs 388-78A-2524(1), -2525(1), and -2526(1). These rules are suspended in response to the significant threat of COVID-19 to our most vulnerable populations, especially for those receiving long-term care services in congregate settings, such as Assisted Living Facilities.

Administrator training is part of the hiring process and must be completed within a designated timeframe. Currently administrators are unable to obtain the required training because that training is no longer being provided due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This circumstance is expected to exacerbate demand for long-term care administrators when the pandemic has already significantly reduced the availability of long-term care workers in the state in recent weeks. These emergency rules are intended to help meet the demand for long-term care administrators in Washington State. The rules expire August 21, 2020.
