ALF #2025-028 CR-101 FILED TO PROPOSE WRITING ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES MEMORY CARE SERVICES CERTIFICATION RULES

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator:

Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5337 (E2SSB 5337) Assisted Living Facilities-Memory Care Services was passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor on April 30, 2025. The bill establishes a certification requirement and process for licensed facilities providing memory care services or specialized dementia services in a memory care facility or memory care unit.

The Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) is proposing to amend and add new sections to <u>Chapter 388-78A WAC</u>. The new and amended sections will establish a process for ALFs to obtain certification and requirements for maintaining a memory care certification. The CR-101 (a preproposal statement of inquiry and notification to the public about plans to revise a rule) under <u>WSR 25-12-025</u> was filed with the Office of the Code Revisor on May 27, 2025, to begin the rulemaking process.
