CR-103E FILED TO EXTEND EMERGENCY RULES AMENDING CERTIFIED COMMUNITY
RESIDENTIAL SERVICES AND SUPPORTS REQUIREMENTS AND CR-101 FILED TO
CONSIDER PERMANENTLY AMENDING THE RULES FOR CERTIFICATION EVALUATIONS

Dear Certified Community Residential Services and Supports Provider

Residential Care Services (RCS) filed an emergency rule (WSR 20-17-012) effective August 6, 2020 related to certification evaluations. The rule was amended in response to the significant threat of COVID-19. The rule expired on December 4, 2020.

On December 3, 2020, RCS filed a CR-103E (WSR 21-01-010) to extend the amended rule. The extension was effective December 4, 2020 and the rule expires on April 2, 2021.

The current rule, WAC 388-101-3130, states the department may conduct an on-site certification evaluation for each service provider at any time, but at least once every two years. The amendment eliminates the maximum two-year timeframe, lengthening the amount of time allowed to complete certification evaluations.

Additionally, RCS filed a CR-101 (WSR 20-24-092) on November 25, 2020 to begin permanent rule making on WAC 388-101-3130 and other related rules. The CR-101 document is available on ALTSA's Information for Certified Community Residential Services and Supports Providers webpage, under "CCRSS Rule Filings."
