ALTSA: CCRSS #2022-005 SAFE START FOR LONG-TERM CARE PLANS REPLACED WITH LONG-TERM CARE COVID RESPONSE PLAN

Dear CCRSS Provider:

The Department of Health and the Department of Social and Health Services have replaced the Safe Start for Long-Term Care Recommendations and Requirements Documents with the Long-Term Care (LTC) COVID Response plan. The updated plan is effective as of February 23, 2022.

The plan also includes the following changes:

- Provides direction and resources to follow guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Department of Health (DOH), and the local health jurisdiction, including specific guidance for each CCRSS setting (Supported Living, Group Home, or Group Training Home);
- Provides specific guidance on screening requirements; and
- Updates visitation recommendations to allow for open visitation in long-term care facilities, unless there is a reasonable clinical or safety cause.
