## ALTSA: ESF #2023-003 CR 103P FILED TO AMEND TRAINING AND HOME CARE AIDE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS IN CHAPTER 388-107 WAC

## Dear Administrator:

This message is to announce the filing of a CR-103P (Permanent Rule) amending chapter 388-107 WAC Licensing Requirements for Enhanced Services Facilities. During the COVID 19 public health emergency, Governor Proclamation 20-10 suspended WAC 388-107-0630 to allow enhanced services facilities to hire home care aides who could not meet training deadline requirements. The department has since adopted rules in chapter 388-112A WAC Residential Long-Term Care Services Training to address the backlog of home care aides needing training and/or testing for certification caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The training rules allow additional time for home care aides to be trained and certified. This amendment to WAC 388-107-0630 aligns enhanced services facilities requirements with the newly adopted requirements in chapter 388-112A WAC and the requirements in chapter 246-980 WAC.

The department filed the CR-103P (<u>WSR 23-03-009</u>) on January 6, 2023. The rule change will take effect on February 6, 2023.
