**AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 388-111 WAC**

Dear ICF/IID Superintendent or Administrator and Interested Parties:

In December 2014, the department began the rulemaking process in order to repeal the Resident Client Protection Program (RCPP) reference sections from Chapter 388-111 WAC. The RCPP program is now a part of the Adult Protective Services (APS) program with Home and Community Services (HCS).

Recently, the department filed the CR-102, a more formal phase of the rule making process. 
