CR-101s FILED TO CONSIDER AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTERS 388-76 (ADULT FAMILY HOME MINIMUM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS), 388-78A (ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY RULES), AND 388-107 (LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR ENHANCED SERVICES FACILITIES) WAC

Dear Administrator/Provider,

The Department of Social and Health Services (Department) is considering amending Chapters 388-76, 388-78A, and 388-107 WAC as may be required to implement the sections in <a href="Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 1120">Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 1120</a> (Chapter 203, Laws of 2021) related to adult family homes, assisted living facilities, and enhanced services facilities. The department filed three Preproposal Statements of Inquiry (CR-101) to address inspection timelines. The following CR-101's were filed to begin the rule-making process to re-establish licensing inspection timelines and document in rule when the inspections were suspended due to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- 21-18-001 for chapter 388-76 WAC was filed on August 18, 2021
- 21-17-123 for chapter 388-78A WAC was filed on August 17, 2021
- 21-17-121 for chapter 388-107 WAC was filed on August 17, 2021
