ALTSA: NH #2016-002 CR 103-E EMERGENCY FILING 388-97 WAC, NURSING HOMES

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator and/or Interested Parties:

In July 2015. CR 101 was filed and a letter was sent notifying Nursing Homes of proposed revisions to 388-97 WAC to assure compliance with the legislation of House Bill 1274 and Substitute Senate Bill 5600. However, by legislative mandate, a stakeholder group was convened to provide opportunity to discuss the bill and rule language and this delayed the development of the rules.

Section 7 (2)(b) of SHB 1274 states "The department shall establish in rule by January 1, 2016, a system of financial penalties for facilities out of compliance with minimum staffing standards." As a result of the delay in rule development, emergency rules have been filed to assure compliance with the January 1, 2016 requirement.

The revised rules will become effective on January 1, 2016 and are published in the Washington State Register as WSR 16-02-043.
