## ALTSA: NH #2016-011 CR 102 FILED TO AMEND CHAPTER 388-97 WAC

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

In July 2015, the department began the rulemaking process to amend sections of Chapter 388-97 to conform to newly passed legislation regarding:

- Changes to definitions in the "Abuse of Vulnerable Adults" law; and
- Changes to the nursing home staffing requirements.

Recently the department filed the CR-102, a more formal phase of the rule making process.
