ALTSA: NH #2018-014 PERMANENT RULE FILING CHAPTER 388-97 WAC

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

In October 2017, the department began the rulemaking process to amend sections of Chapter 388-97 to reflect current federal requirements related to the electronic transmittal of the resident assessment instrument (RAI). The new requirement will extend the time to transmit the RAI to fourteen days, matching current federal requirements.

The permanent rule filing (CR103P) was filed on May 2, 2018 with the Office of the Code Reviser – WSR #18-11-001. The permanent rule will take effect on June 2, 2018.
