ALTSA: NH #2019-012 CR-101 RE-FILED TO PROPOSE AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 388-97 WAC (GERIATRIC SPECIALTY TRAINING

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

The Department is adding and amending these rules as required by federal or state law or required to maintain federally delegated or authorized programs; and to assure compliance with requirements from the 2016-2017 passed legislation for ESHB 1548 and the 2019 passed legislation for HB 1349.

CR-101 (WSR 19-03-167), originally filed to make these proposed changes, was withdrawn in order to re-file with an amended scope to accommodate recently passed legislation.

CR-101 (WSR 19-12-109) was filed on June 5, 2019. A link to the CR-101 document (<u>WSR 19-12-109</u>) is available on ALTSA's <u>Information for Nursing Home Professionals web page</u>, under "NH Rule Filings."

The sections to WAC 388-97 under review will include 388-97-1090, to update staff training requirements related to geriatric behavioral health workers.
