RESCINDING CR-103E FOR WAC 388-97-1380, TUBERCULOSIS – TESTING REQUIRED AND
WAC 388-97-1580, TUBERCULOSIS – TEST RECORDS

Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

In January 2021, the Department of Social and Health Services (the department) filed emergency rules for WAC 388-97-1380 and WAC 388-97-1580 related to Tuberculosis (TB) testing to permit deferral of TB testing for staff and residents for COVID-19 vaccinations due to clinical interference. This emergency rule was extended several times.

On August 31, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced that the COVID-19 vaccination should not be delayed because of testing for TB infection (follow this link to read the full CDC guidance). Testing for TB infection with one of the immune-based methods, either the tuberculin skin test (TST) or an interferon gamma release assay (IGRA) can be done before, after, or during the same encounter as COVID-19 vaccination. Therefore, the department rescinded WSR 21-18-064 under WSR 21-20-018 on September 23, 2021, as the separation of the TB test and COVID-19 vaccine is no longer recommended.
