Dear Nursing Facility/Home Administrator:

On June 30, 2022, the **DSHS 10-207 form**, titled "Nursing Home State Survey Report," was reinstated to fulfill state requirements so that facilities were given fair notice and due process for rules (Washington Administrative Code) that were cited with the associated federal regulations (F-tags).

On May 16, 2024, the DSHS 10-207 form was revised and approved for release to include instructions for both Residential Care Services (RCS) staff and Licensees (providers).

Effective immediately, RCS staff will begin using the updated DSHS 10-207 form.
