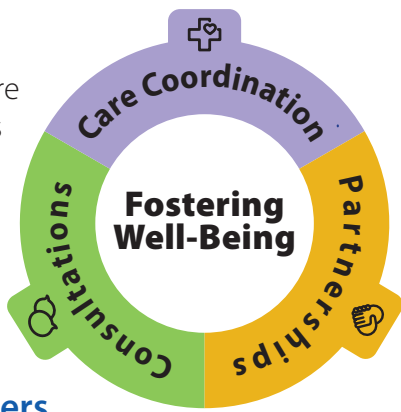
*Fostering Well-Being provides care coordination and consultation for children in foster care and extended foster care.*



## Our Team Can Help

### Caregivers

Navigate the healthcare system, find specialists and assist with Apple Health benefit denials and prior authorizations.



### Social Workers & Tribal Social Workers

Answer medical questions, review medical records, create child-specific comprehensive health overviews and assist with Apple Health denials and prior authorizations.

## Program Eligibility

FWB can help if the child receives Apple Health (Medicaid fee-for service) and is:

- Birth to 18 years old in foster care or up to 21 years old in extended foster care.
- Native American/Alaskan Native (tribal affiliated, tribal custody payment only with DCYF), a non-citizen or enrolled in Medically Intensive Children's Program.
