# ZERO INCOME: RESOURCES AND SUPPORTS



### What if a client has zero income?

ALTSA clients with zero income remain eligible for our housing resources.

### How do they pay for rent?

With a subsidy (federal or state), clients have a guaranteed rent payment up to the full amount. They are also eligible for additional ALTSA resources to help secure and maintain housing.

## If an individual is not eligible for housing through ALTSA, other community resources can be accessed:

#### **ESSENTIAL ITEMS**

- 211 Community Resources: Seek a wide variety of statewide community resources.
- Aged, Blind, or Disabled (ABD) Cash Assistance Program: Clients may be eligible for ABD cash assistance, as well as get referred to the Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) Program.
- <u>Washington State Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP):</u> CCGs can help clients access utility assistance, including ongoing programs. Find contact information in the client's county.
- Obtain an ID: Washington State Department of Licensing: Help your client get a picture ID. Find the 16-029 Identicard request form in Barcode. Sign and provide the form to your client. A CCG may be utilized if the client has no funds available.

### **WORKING WITH LANDLORDS**

Reassure landlords or property managers that ALTSA clients with a subsidy have guaranteed timely rent payments for up to the entire amount due.

- <u>Income Discrimination Flyer</u>: Individuals are protected from housing discrimination based on source of income. Washington Law Help also provides free legal information.
- Northwest Justice Project: Clients may apply to receive free legal services and advice.
