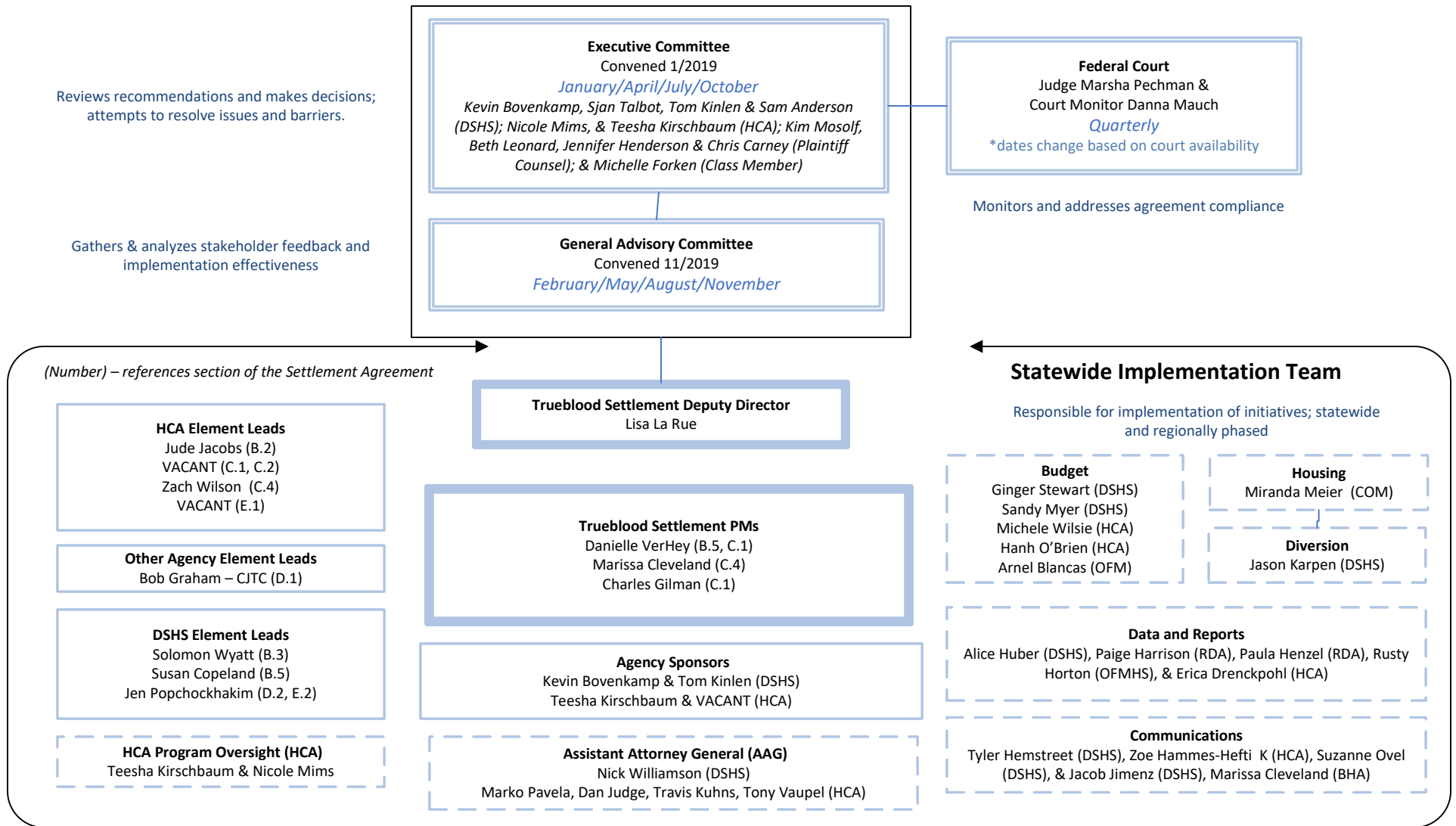


Trueblood Settlement of Contempt

LEGAL

General Advisory Committee

Gathers & analyzes stakeholder feedback and implementation effectiveness.

- Meet quarterly
- Terms align w/Phase length
- Selected/Invited by Executive Committee
- Make recommendations to Executive Committee

Executive Committee

Reviews recommendations and makes decisions; attempts to resolve issues and barriers.

- Meet quarterly
- Specific agency members determined by agency leadership
- Peer member
- Legal representation for states by AGO
- Decision-making body

Federal Court

Monitors compliance to the Agreement and addresses non-compliance.

- Quarterly Status Hearings
- Assigned Court Monitor Danna Mauch
- Invites experts and others as desired
- Controls disbursement of contempt funds

AGENCY

Agency Sponsor

- Meet every other week w/Senior PM
- Sponsor for entirety of TB related projects owned by agency
- Member of Executive and General Advisory Committees

Agency Leadership

(not sponsors)

- Agency sponsors are in their chain of command
- May attend Status Hearings, may be a member of Executive and General Advisory Committees
- Participate in agency review processes

Agency Review Processes

- Format and attendees vary by agency
- Timing varies by process
- Include daily huddles or emails, project review cycles, etc.

LEGAL

Federal Court

- Quarterly Status Hearings
- Assigned Court Monitor
- Invites experts & others as desired
- Controls disbursement of contempt funds

Executive Committee

- Meets quarterly
- Specific agency members determined by agency leadership
- Peer member
- State legal representation by AGO
- Decision-making body

General Advisory Committee (GAC)

- Meets quarterly
- Terms align w/Phase length
- Selected/Invited by Exec. Committee
- Make recommendations to Executive Committee

AGENCY

Agency Sponsors

- Meets biweekly with Senior PM
- Sponsor for entirety of TB projects owned by agency
- Member of Executive and GAC

Agency Leadership (not sponsors)

- Agency sponsors are in their chain of command
- May attend Status Hearings, may be a member of Executive and GAC
- Participates in agency review processes

Agency Review Processes

- Format and attendees vary by agency
- Timing varies by process
- Includes daily huddles or emails, project review cycles, etc.

LEGISLATIVE

Behavioral Health Recovery System Transformation (BHRST) Task Force

- Meets quarterly
- Duties outlined in HB 1109
- Must report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and appropriate committees of the Legislature by 12/1/20.
