## Scenario 1 - Self-Support Reserve

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, and child age 6.
- Dad is receiving TANF with the child.
- Dad is the custodial parent.
- Impute minimum wage to Dad.
- Mom works for minimum wage (\$8.67 / hour).
- What is Mom's support obligation?

Proportionate Share: 50\%-50\%

Apply SSR (\$1134)
Transfer Payment \$166

## Betson ET

BSO w/o limitations \$286
Apply SSR (\$1134)
Transfer Payment \$166

## Scenario 2 Presumptive Minimum

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, 4 children, ages $6,8,13$, and 17.
- Dad is custodial parent.
- Mom makes minimum wage.
- Dad makes minimum wage.
- No daycare.

What is Mom's support obligation?

## Scenario 2 - Presumptive Minimum

Mom's MNI \$1300<br>Dad's MNI \$1300<br>CMNI \$2600

Proportionate Share: 50\%-50\%

BSO w/o limitations $\$ 655$
Apply SSR (\$1134)
Transfer Payment \$200

## Betson ET

BSO w/o limitations $\$ 600$
Apply SSR (\$1134)
Transfer Payment \$200

## Scenario 3-45\% Limitation

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, 1 child age 13.
- Mom makes minimum wage.
- Dad makes \$11.00 per hour (\$1,907.00 gross/month).
- Mom is the custodial parent.
- Dad has two other children.

What is Dad's support obligation?

## Scenario 3-45\% Limitation

Mom's MNI \$1300<br>Dad's MNI \$1621 CMNI \$2921

Proportionate Share: Dad 55\% - Mom 45\%

Transfer Payment \$243* *WFF would give \$247

## Scenario 4 - Whole Family Formula

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, 3 children:
- Ages 6, 8, 13.
- Mom is the custodial parent of all 3 children.
- Mom makes minimum wage.
- Dad makes \$3,000.00 per month.
- Dad has a child from another relationship. What is Dad's support obligation?


## Scenario 4 - Whole Family Formula

Mom's MNI \$1300<br>Dad's MNI \$2488<br>CMNI \$3788

Proportionate Share: Dad 66\% - Mom 34\%

## Current ET

BSO w/o limitations \$802
Whole Family Formula
Transfer Payment \$678*
*45\% limitation would give \$840

## Betson ET

BSO w/o limitations \$1003
45\% Limitation
Transfer Payment \$840*
*WFF would give \$853

## Scenario 5 - Higher Income

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, 3 children, ages 6,8 , and 13.
- Mom is the custodial parent of all 3 children.
- Mom makes $\$ 1863$ gross per month.
- Mom pays $\$ 925$ per month daycare.
- Dad makes \$9,150 gross per month.

What is Dad's support obligation?

## Scenario 5 - Higher Income

Mom's MNI \$1586 Dad's MNI \$6749 CMNI \$8355

Proportionate Share: Dad 81\% - Mom 19\%

## Current ET

BSO w/o limitations \$1929

+ 749 daycare =
Transfer Payment \$2678


## Betson ET

BSO w/o limitations \$1934

+ $\$ 749$ daycare =
Transfer Payment \$ 2684


## Scenario 6 - Arvey Calculation

- Family consists of Mom, Dad, 3 children, ages 6,8 , and 13 .
- Mom is the custodial parent of 6 \& 8 y.o. kids
- Dad is the custodial parent of the 13 year old.
- Mom makes minimum wage.
- Dad makes $\$ 3,000.00$ per month.
- No daycare.

What is Dad's support obligation?

## Scenario 6 - Arvey Calculation

Mom's MNI \$1300 Dad's MNI \$2488<br>CMNI \$3788

Proportionate Share: Dad 66\% - Mom 34\%

## Current ET

Using Arvey Calculation,
Dad \$496 - Mom \$160 =
Transfer Payment \$336

## Betson ET

Using Arvey Calculation,
Dad \$688- Mom \$175 =
Transfer Payment \$513
