Summary

In response to the final rules for the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002, the following changes were made to the TFA section of the EAZ manual:

WAC 388-489-0015, “How long will my household receive transitional food assistance?”

- Replaced the word “family” with “household” to keep the terminology consistent with other sections of the WAC.
- Replaced the reference to WAC 388-489-0020 with WAC 388-489-0022 in subsection (4) of the WAC.

WAC 388-489-0020, “Am I required to report changes in my household’s circumstances while on transitional food assistance?”

- Replaced the word “family” with “household” to keep the terminology consistent with other sections of the WAC.
- Added a reference to WAC 388-489-0022 in subsection (3).
- Removed subsections (3) (a) and (3) (b). The content of these subsections were moved to WAC 388-489-0022.

WAC 388-489-0022, “What happens if I reapply for Basic Food while receiving transitional food assistance?”

- New section to the TFA chapter that establishes the procedure for what to do when someone on TFA applies for Basic Food, such as:
 - Keeping a TFA case active while an application for Basic Food is pending.
 - Opening a new Basic Food certification period effective the first of the month following the month of application.
 - Processing a supplement or overpayment for the difference between the TFA and Basic Food amount, if the household has already received the TFA benefits in the first month of the new Basic Food certification period.
 - Giving the client the choice to stay on TFA if the Basic Food benefits would be less.

As a result of the WAC changes, some of the Clarifying Information and Workers Responsibilities for this section was updated and reorganized.
