CLARIFYING INFORMATION

. BF-E&T Participant ReimbursementsSupport Services and Work-First Support Services:

Prior receipt of Work First support services or concurrent receipt of post-TANF support services does not affect potential eligibility for the following BF-E&T support servicesparticipant reimbursements:

a. Transportation allowance for participants:

BF-E&T participants are eligible formay receive a maximum \$100-150 allowance per month for transportation or other-costs related to participation. Bus passes and gas vouchers are allowed permitted under this allowance and will may be paid authorized by DSHS and the Employment Security Department (ESD) using the JOBS Automated the BFET Provider (contractor) upon availability of fundsSystem (eJAS).

b. Clothing allowance for participants:

BF-E&T participants may receive a <u>maximum</u> \$2300 clothing allowance once in thea 12 month period from October <u>1 to September 30</u>. Vouchers are created and payments approved through eJAS. This allowance may be authorized by the BFET Provider upon availability of funds.

- 2. Dependent care allowance Non-ABAWD participants only:
 - a. Allowed to BF-E&T participants ages 16 through 59 with dependents.
 - b. Allowed for children up to ages 6 through 12.
 - c. <u>Allowed when: Subject to funds availability by the Child Care Subsidy Programs (CCSP) and/or</u> <u>BFET.</u>
 - c.d. Must follow all other rules as established by CCSP unless the funding is directly from BFET.

i. No other person in the household is available to provide care; and

ii. There is no other informal resource available.
