Refugee Cash Assistance and Refugee Medical Assistance

Refugee Cash Assistance is a federally funded program that provides up to 12 months of cash assistance to single and married adults with an eligible immigration status who do not have dependents.

Refugee Medical Assistance is a federally funded medical assistance program available to refugees and eligible immigrants for up to 12 months for those who are ineligible for Washington Apple Health (Medicaid). Since the expansion of Medicaid, less than 1% of all refugee and humanitarian immigrant individuals and families are ineligible for Washington Apple Health. In an average year, fewer than 100 arrivals a year receive RMA.

DSHS seeks to improve the lives of clients receiving RCA by ensuring all participants receive consistent referrals to employment, education and social service providers to support them in enhancing their English skills, finding and maintaining employment and moving toward independence.

Who is eligible for RCA?

- Refugees
- People granted asylum ("asylees")
- Certified Victims of Human Trafficking
- Citizens and nationals of Afghanistan paroled¹ into the United States between July 31, 2021 and Sept. 30, 2023.
- Citizens and nationals of Ukraine paroled into the United States. between Feb. 24, 2022 and Sept. 30, 2024.
- · Amerasians.
- Cuban-Haitian entrants.
- Special Immigrant Visa holders from Iraq and Afghanistan.


