LTC Updates

(1) Testing

- New testing procedures: LTC have devised new testing procedures; tried the procedures with small numbers of employee tests in August and September
- To resume employee tests on small scales in Olympia and Yakima in October and November
- No plan for testing public candidates for now
- No significant changes in active credentials: The numbers of active credentials stay stable in the past months (e.g. around 4,300 or above in September and October 2020)

(2) New LTC database (LTC Gateway)

- Project on good track: Dev team is doing tests and preparing for launch.
- Tentative launch date: 11/13/2020
- LTC's preparation for launch:
 - Writing user manual: Detailed step-by-step instructions of user functions; will be posted at due time
 - Pause of LTC services during launch period:
 - * Not accepting CE applications during 10/20/2020-11/30/2020
 - * Unable to enter CE credits during 11/1/2020-11/30/2020
 - Impact: "Find an Interpreter" tool will not be updated, but the impact is little and manageable.
 - * Only a small number (about 50) of interpreters and translators have credentials that will expire during 11/1/2020-11/30/2020: A large proportion have already fulfilled renewal requirements and their credential status will not be impacted; among the rest, some won't be renewed due to failure to submit annual ethics credits; those who still need some General Credits have been notified to submit before launch period starts.
 - * Interpreters and translators, or their employers, can reach out to LTC if they need to confirm the status of a credential.
 - Communication with stakeholders
 - * Posted notices on LTC website about the new database and pause of services during the launch period
 - * Begun to include relevant information in LTC staff's routine Email responses to customers
 - * Sent Email to the Advisory Committee, language agencies, WASCLA, and DSHS language access advisors
