Washington State law RCW 13.40.215(5) states that "upon discharge, parole, transfer to a community residential facility, or other authorized leave or release, a convicted juvenile sex offender shall not attend a public or approved private elementary, middle, or high school that is attended by a victim or sibling of a victim of the sex offender."

The Department of Social and Health Services Sex Offender School Attendance Program assists with ensuring that juvenile sex offenders, committed to the Juvenile Rehabilitation Administration, do not enroll in the same school as your child/children. To ensure this does not happen we need you to fill out the attached School Information Request form and return it to us. Please keep our office informed if your child/children change schools.
