Here are the steps

1 Licensed business owners can find out if they are eligible for either the state or federal program (or both) through the Office of Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (OMWBE) at: www.business.wa.gov

2 If you are eligible, apply for certification through OMWBE at: www.omwbe.wa.gov/certification/

If you don't have a business license ...

If you are a veteran ...

The Washington State Department of Veterans Affairs promotes Veteran/Service Member Owned Businesses. Check out the Business Registry at: www.dva.wa.gov/program/business-registry
