In addition to BFET, you may be eligible for Employment Pipeline services.

The Employment Pipeline is a voluntary employment and training program offered by the Community Services Division of DSHS. EP Navigators leverage local system resources and help individuals navigate the local workforce development systems in these areas for better connection with employment and training opportunities and the necessary supports, including referrals to address barriers, and 12 months of employment retention services. EP has Navigators across all of Washington state, including all 12 workforce development areas. Some examples include Spokane, King County, Snohomish, Olympic, Pacific Mountain, Tacoma-Pierce County, Yakima County and Southwest Washington.
