What is Supported Employment in State Government?

SESG Program, RCW 41.04.750, was adopted by the Legislature in 1999. It provides paid competitive integrated employment opportunities in state agencies and state institutions of higher education for individuals with developmental and other significant disabilities who require on-the-job training and long-term support in order to fulfill their job duties successfully and offers the same wages and benefits as non-supported employment positions.

How can DVR assist?

The DVR Supported Employment Program Manager can assist you with developing a SESG position, recruiting and selecting applicants, and will continue to be a resource for your agency.
