## **DSHS High School Home Care Aide Instructor** — Qualification Requirements\*

## All instructors must:

- 1. Be at least 21 years of age.
- 2. Have **not** had a professional, adult family home, assisted living facility, or social services license or certification revoked in Washington state.
- 3. **In addition to the general qualifications listed above**, an instructor must meet the education, work and teaching experience qualifications listed below for DSHS approval
