

CSTC Family Hardship Grant

Families and guardians are critically important to a youth's success in long-term treatment. Regular participation in treatment planning meetings and consistent in-person contact with families and guardians allow youth to practice generalizing skills and prepare for a successful return to the community.



What does the hardship grant support?

The grant provides reimbursement for family travel and lodging to facilitate participation in treatment activities that support a youth's discharge. Examples may include attending family therapy or family/guardian skills training programming, on-campus visitation, or community based therapeutic leave (pass).
