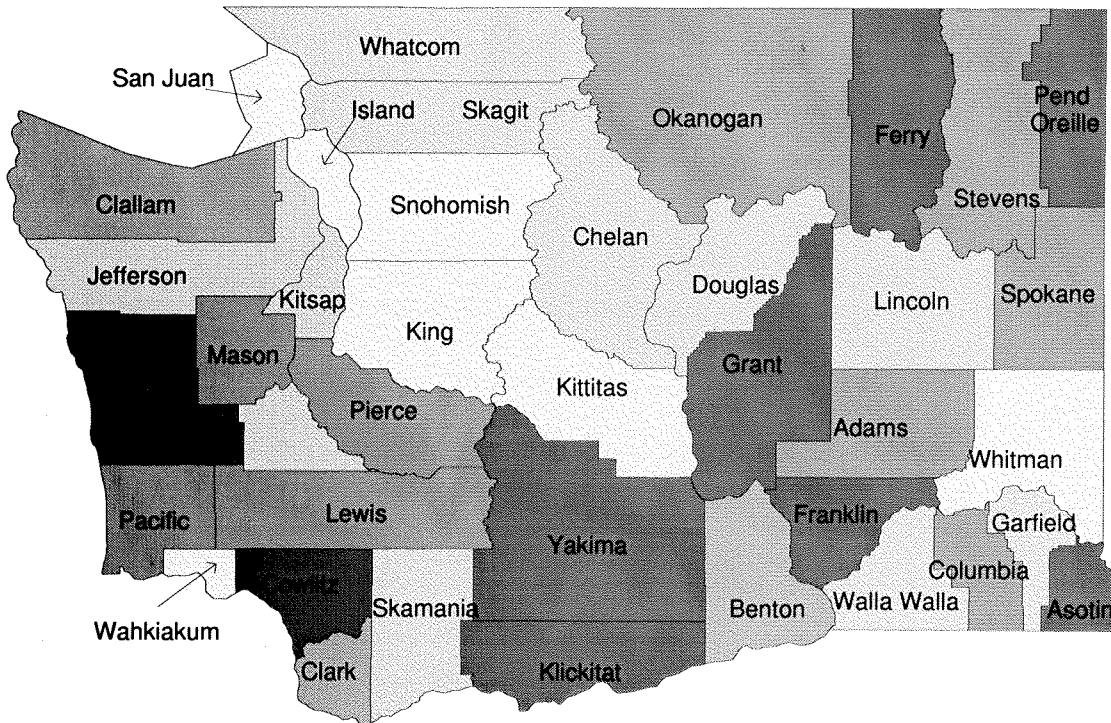

TANF Clients as a Percent of County's Population for the Fiscal Year 1998

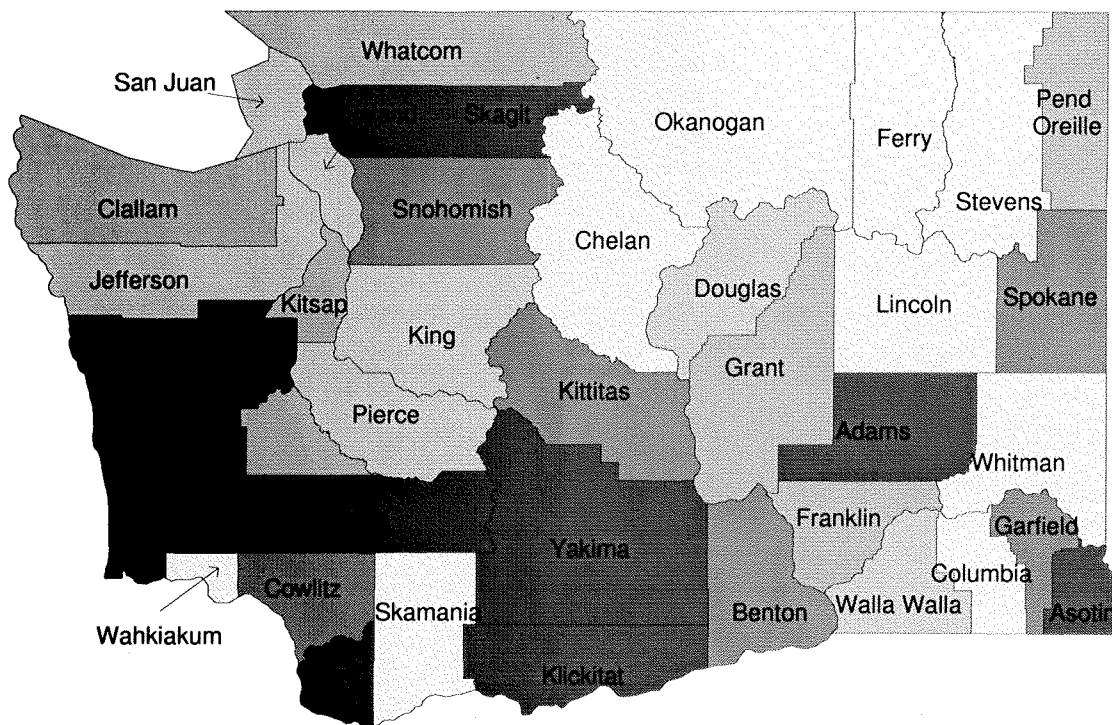


TANF Clients as a Percent

Diversion Clients as a Percent of County's Population for the Fiscal Year 1998

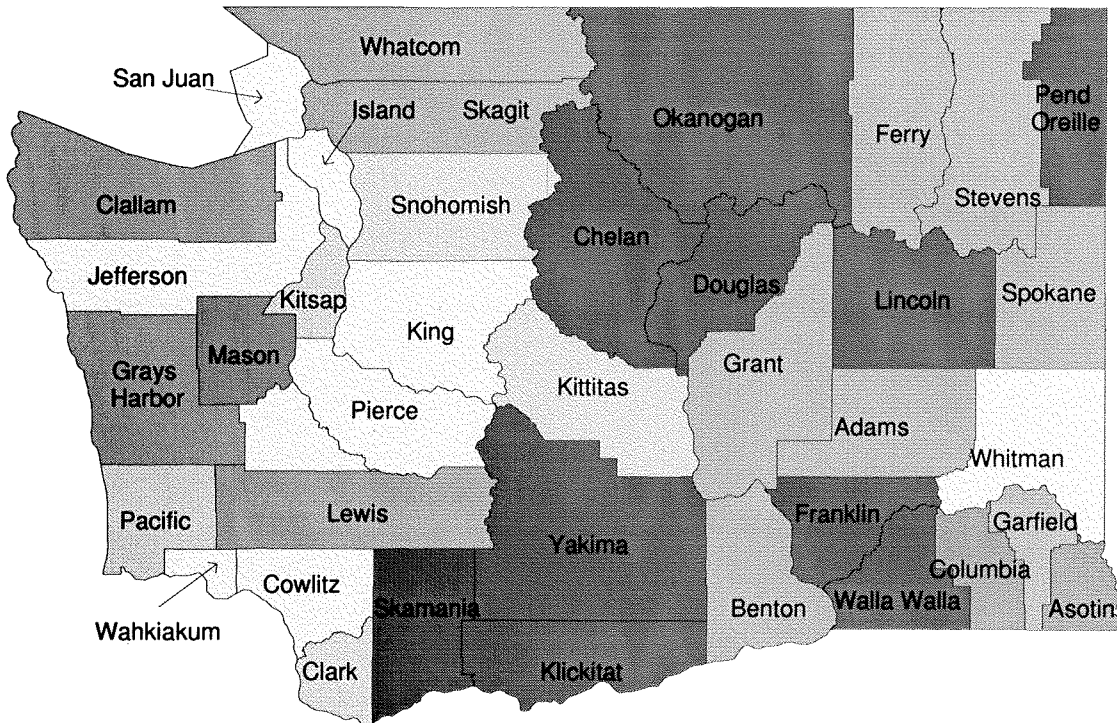

CEAP Clients as a Percent of County's Population for the Fiscal Year 1998



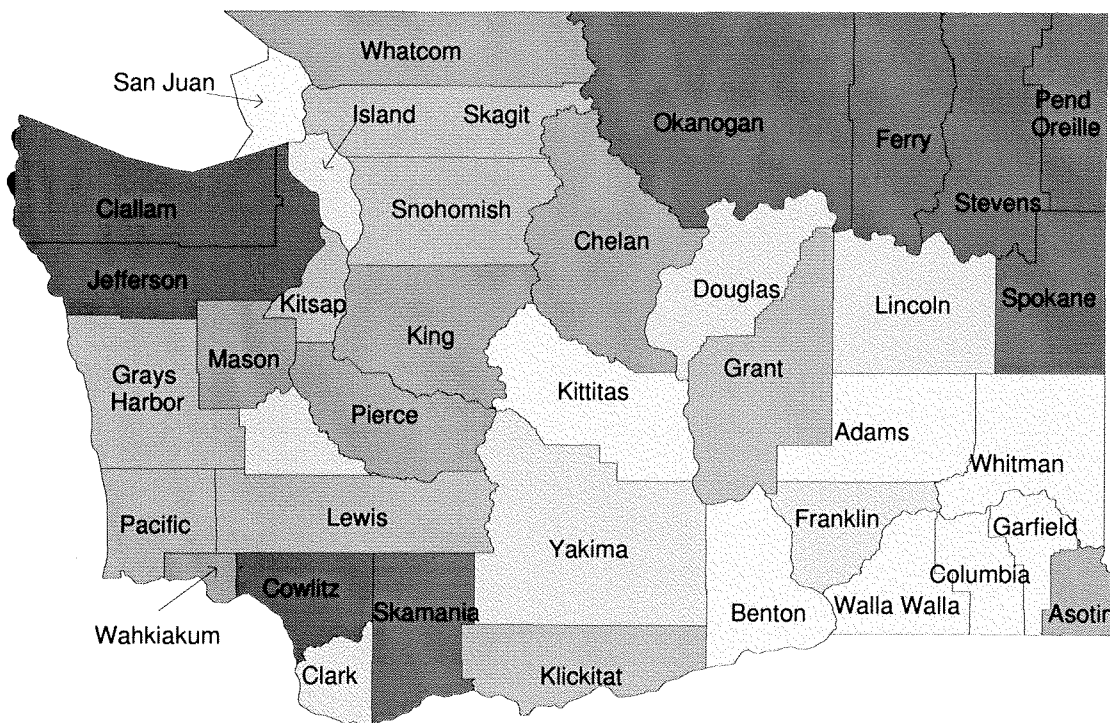
CEAP Clients as a Percent of the Total Population

GA-U & GA-X Clients as a Percent of County's Population for the Fiscal Year 1998

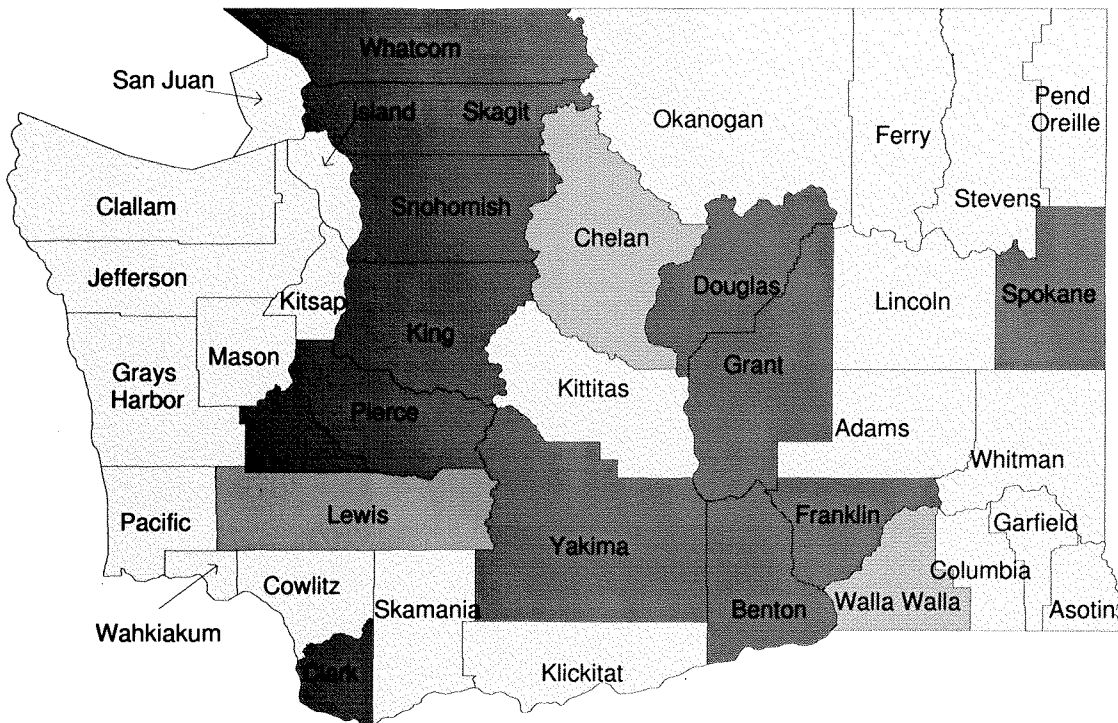


GA-U & GA-X Clients as a Percent of the Total Population

Refugee Clients as a Percent of County's Population for the Fiscal Year 1998



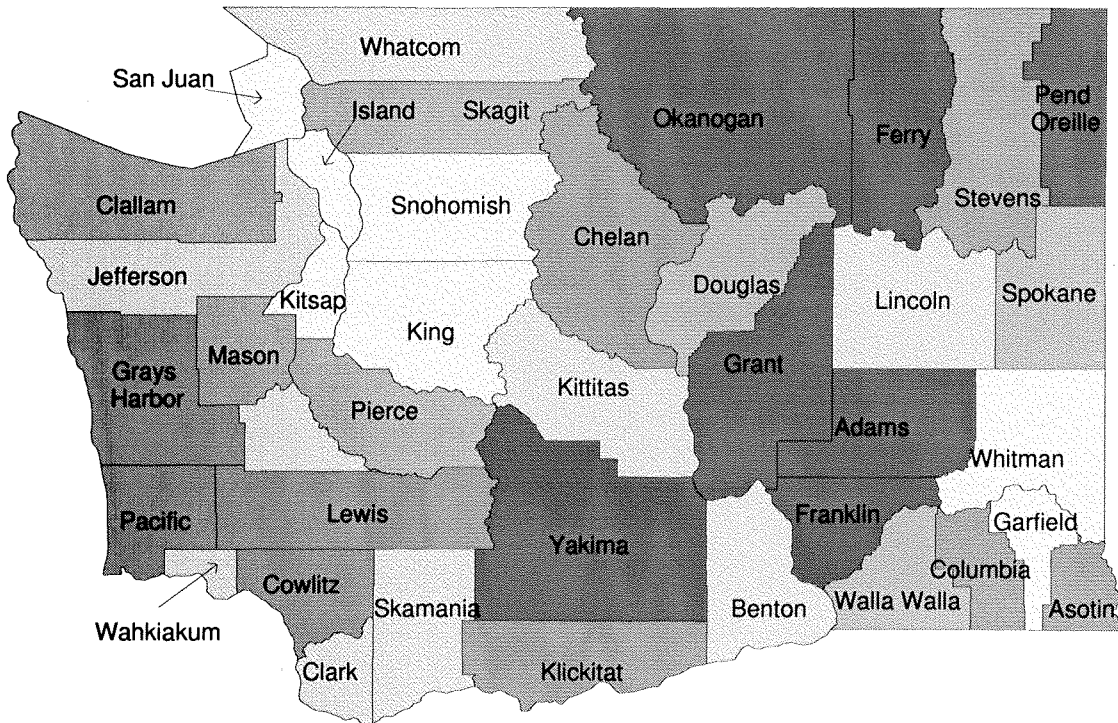

Medical Clients as a Percent of the Total Population

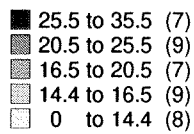
