County Profiles:

Birth and Unintended Pregnancy Statistics, 1991-1998

SUMMARY

This report, the third of its series, presents birth and unintended pregnancy statistics for each of the 39 counties in Washington State. These data include selected demographic and pregnancy-related indicators obtained from vital statistics, Medicaid administrative records, and survey data collected on a sample of women giving birth. A separate report (*CSO Profiles*, 2000) presents these measures for geographies surrounding the Department of Social and Health Services Community Services Offices.

Numbers of births. The numbers of births in this report include all births, including those classified as fetal deaths, available through the First Steps Database. The average number of births fell slightly from 79,784 in 1991-92 to 77,657 in 1995-96. The number of births increased to 79,698 in 1998. Despite increased numbers of births, the birth rate among women ages 15-44 has steadily decreased, from 67.7 to 64.1 births per 1,000.

Births with Medicaid-paid maternity care. Pregnant women with family incomes at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level are eligible for medical coverage through Medicaid in Washington State. The proportion of births to women with Medicaid-paid maternity care is an indication of a community's economic status. In 1998, 41.0% of Washington births were to Medicaid-eligible women. This proportion ranged from 29.7% in Snohomish County to 83.8% in Ferry County, reflecting economic differences within Washington.

Subsequent births within two years. The proportion of women who had a subsequent birth within two years decreased for all age groups from 1991-92 to 1995-96, both for the overall population of Washington women and for the subgroup of women receiving grant assistance. Among Washington women aged 15-39, grouped by age, the decrease in subsequent births ranged from 19.0% for women aged 30-34, to 30.2% for those aged 15-17. Among Washington women aged 15-39 and receiving grant assistance at the time of their earlier birth, the decrease ranged from a 21.5% decrease in the proportion of subsequent births for women aged 18-19, to a 28.5% decrease for women aged 20-24.

Unintended pregnancy statistics. This report provides several measures of unintended pregnancy: the number of abortions reported anonymously by state providers, abortion rates, and estimates of the number and rate of births from unintended pregnancy. Statewide and county rates of births from unintended pregnancy are applied estimates based on data from the Department of Health's annual Pregnancy Risk Assessment and Monitoring System (PRAMS) survey of approximately 3,000 women. The PRAMS survey contains a question on pregnancy intendedness. Births from unintended pregnancy includes births to women who stated their pregnancy was either mistimed (wanted later) or unwanted at the time of conception. County-level estimates of births from unintended pregnancies were adjusted for Medicaid status as a proxy for socioeconomic status. Using these estimates, in 1998 approximately 38% of all Washington births (28% Non Medicaid; 53% Medicaid) were unintended at the time of

conception. Taking abortions into account, over one-half (53%) of all pregnancies in 1998 were unintended. Estimates of 1998 unintended pregnancy rates, including abortions, ranged from 41% in Garfield County to 59% in Jefferson County, with most (N=32) counties above 50%.

Number and Rates of Births and Abortions. The numbers and rates of births are reported for four two-year time periods, from 1991-92 to 1997-98, and for the single years 1997 and 1998. Rates are reported per 1,000 women. The birth rate for women ages 15-44 decreased from 67.7 in 1991-92 to 63.6 in 1997-98. The decrease was primarily among women less than 24 years old. Abortion rates also decreased during this time, from a rate of 24.6 per 1,000 women to 21.2 per 1,000 women.

Birth Rates at the County Level. Birth rates at the county level ranged from 33.9 to 109.0 per 1,000 in 1997-98. Seven counties (Adams, Chelan, Douglas, Franklin, Grant, Okanogan, and Yakima) have birth rates of greater than 70 per 1000.

CONCLUSIONS

Birth- and pregnancy-related measures presented in this report vary by individual county. A wide range of differences in county characteristics such as mother's Medicaid status is reflected by differences in county birth rates, abortion rates, unintended pregnancies, and birth statistics. In general, however, birth- and pregnancy-related measures have exhibited a downward trend from 1991-92 to 1998. Birth rates, abortion rates, the proportion of unintended pregnancies, and the proportion of subsequent births within two years have all decreased in Washington State during this time period.

METHODS

Data tables in this report are similar in format to the August 1997 and August 1998 County Profiles Reports published by the Department of Social and Health Services. A major difference in methods for this report, however, is that the number of births includes all births (not restricted to live births) from the First Steps Database. The previous two reports reported all live births reported by the Department of Health - Center for Health Statistics. Data are presented in average annual numbers and rates for two-year intervals, covering the periods 1991-1992 through 1997-1998 and annual data for 1997 and 1998.

Various sources were used to compile data for the abortion and birth rates, unintended pregnancy rates and Medicaid statistics in the data tables. The methods section is organized by each item's order of appearance in the data tables.

Data Sources

Population estimates provide the basis for calculating changes in context with population growth. Age specific population estimates are based on data from the Office of Financial Management (OFM). The population estimates used in this report are available electronically at http://www.ofm.wa.gov/agesexcensal/est80-99.xls.

The <u>First Steps Database</u> (FSDB) links vital statistics from birth and death certificates to information on Medicaid-paid maternity services and Medicaid eligibility files. In order to do so, it relies on information obtained from the Medical Assistance Administration (MAA) and the Department of Health - Center for Health Statistics (DOH-CHS). The merging of these data into one database allows population-based analyses of maternal and child health issues by a wide range of factors such as age, income, gender, race and ethnicity.

<u>PRAMS</u>, the Pregnancy Risk Assessment and Monitoring System, is an ongoing, population-based surveillance system sponsored by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and implemented in Washington by the state Department of Health (DOH). PRAMS survey data from 1993-98 were linked to the FSDB to provide statewide estimates of the proportion of women with unintended pregnancies by Medicaid status.

All data on cash assistance eligibility and Medicaid eligibility were determined using the Office of Financial Management Eligibility History File.

Methods

Birth Data

The number of births reported includes all births, born alive or dead, available in the First Steps Database.

Low-income, pregnant women that are eligible to receive medical assistance services funded through the Medicaid program, created through Title XIX of the Social Security Act, are included

in the number of women with Medicaid paid maternity care. Pregnant, Medicaid-eligible women may receive expanded coverage prenatal care, delivery and postpartum care in addition to a wide range of covered medical services for enrolled clients. Women who qualify for Medicaid (largely determined by income level) fall into two main groups: (1) those who receive both Medicaid and cash assistance (Grant Recipients), and (2) those who receive only Medicaid services (Other Medicaid).

The percent of births with Medicaid paid maternity care represents the proportion of total births identified as receiving Medicaid paid maternity care, through use of the First Steps Database.

Subsequent births to Washington women who had a delivery 1991-1996 were identified through the First Steps Database. Birth certificate information was compared across years through 1998 to identify births to the same mother.

Unintended Pregnancy Statistics

Unintended pregnancy statistics help states to assess the need for family planning services (Dietz et al., 1999; Melvin et al., 2000). The number of induced abortions and the estimated number of births from an unintended pregnancy provide the basis for the unintended pregnancy measures used in this report: unintended pregnancy rates.

Number of Abortions.

The number of abortions reflects numbers reported by DOH-CHS in Table 20, Induced Abortions by Woman's Age and County of Residence, *Pregnancy and Induced Abortion Statistics*. Table 20 for the most recent year is also available electronically at http://www.doh.wa.gov/EHSPHL/CHS/at18.xls.

Estimated Births from Unintended Pregnancy

The percent of births from unintended pregnancies is the proportion of births from unintended pregnancies among all births, also referred to as the unintended pregnancy rate for births.

The PRAMS annual survey of women who gave birth contains a question on how the woman felt about her pregnancy at the time of conception. Women who answered that at the time of conception they would have preferred to become pregnant at a later time or not at all are categorized as having a birth from an unintended pregnancy.

Due to the PRAMS sampling strategy and sampling size, it is not possible to directly compute numbers of unintended pregnancies at the county level. In order to estimate a county-specific unintended pregnancy rate that reflected the diversity in characteristics of women giving birth across Washington counties, the statewide unintended pregnancy rate was adjusted by Medicaid status as a proxy measure of socioeconomic status.

PRAMS sample data were linked to the First Steps Database, which contains Medicaid information, and weighted to produce an estimate of the statewide unintended pregnancy rate across three different Medicaid categories. These rates were then applied to the distribution of births to women in these categories in each county to obtain each county's estimated number of

unintended pregnancies. An average of the unintended pregnancy rate for 1993-94 births was used for years prior to 1994.

In 1993-94 an estimated 28.3% of births to higher income women (non-Medicaid) were from unintended pregnancies, compared to 54.0% and 68.6% of births to those receiving publicly funded maternity care assistance (Other Medicaid and Grant Recipients).

The following hypothetical example illustrates application of this weighting methodology: In 1993, County X had 300 births distributed equally among the three Medicaid groups (non-Medicaid, Other Medicaid, and Grant Recipients). The number of unintended births is estimated to be $(100 \times .283) + (100 \times .540) + (100 \times .686) = 151$. County Y, a comparatively affluent county, also had 300 births: 200 to higher income women (Non-Medicaid), 70 to women receiving only Medicaid paid maternity care (Other Medicaid), and 30 with both Medicaid and cash assistance (Grant Recipients). The number of unintended births for County Y is estimated to be 95 [$(200 \times .283) + (70 \times .540) + (30 \times .686)$].

Estimated Total Unintended Pregnancies

Total unintended pregnancies is the estimated number of total pregnancies that were unintended. It is the sum of the number of abortions and the estimated births from unintended pregnancies. All induced abortions were assumed to represent unintended pregnancies.

The percent of total unintended pregnancies is the proportion of estimated total unintended pregnancies among all pregnancies.

Estimated Cost of Publicly Funded Maternity Care for Births from Unintended Pregnancies

The estimated cost of publicly funded maternity care for births from unintended pregnancies illustrates the economic impact that an unintended pregnancy has on state resources. This measure applies the average cost of maternity care among all women with Medicaid paid births to the estimated number of unintended pregnancies.

The Medical Assistance Administration (MAA, 2000) estimates that the average prenatal care and delivery expenditures for women with Medicaid funded births from 1991 to 1998 were \$3401, \$3911, \$4367, \$4762, \$4764, \$5034, \$5255, and \$5639. The 1991 estimated cost of publicly funded maternity care for births from unintended pregnancies for a county with 100 Grant Recipient Births and 100 Other Medicaid Births would be equal to the total number of births from unintended pregnancies for that group multiplied by the estimate of average publicly paid Maternity Cost:

Estimated publicly funded costs for the maternity care associated with unintended pregnancies would be \$417,153 for this hypothetical county in 1991.

Statistics for Births

The information on marital status, late or no prenatal care, and low birthweight comes from birth certificate information collected by DOH-CHS as provided to the FSDB.

Late or no prenatal care refers to the month that women giving birth indicated they started prenatal care. If a mother indicated prenatal care began in or after the sixth month of pregnancy or not at all, this was considered to be late or no prenatal care. Marital status refers to a mother's self-report of marital status at the time of delivery. Rates of late or no prenatal care were calculated among all women giving birth.

Low birthweight refers to the relative weight of the infant at birth. All singleton liveborn infants with a birth weight under 2,500 grams (5.5 lbs.) are identified as low birthweight. The rate of low birthweight infants was calculated as the total number of low birthweight infants among all singleton liveborn births. Singleton liveborn births are births where the delivery did not result in a stillborn or in multiple births.

Rates of marital status, prenatal care and low birthweight were similarly calculated for the subgroup of women in the county who received Medicaid-paid maternity care.

Birth and Abortion Rates

The age-specific birth and abortion rates are based on the numbers of live births and induced abortions reported by the Washington Department of Health Center for Health Statistics and OFM population estimates. Age-specific birth rates were calculated as the number of births per 1,000 women in each age group. Abortion rates were similarly calculated.

Abortion data are reported anonymously to the Department of Health Center for Health Statistics (DOH-CHS). Reported data contains only general information, such as the woman's county of residence and age. DOH-CHS publishes age-specific numbers of live births and induced abortions by county of residence (Tables 18 and 20) in *Pregnancy and Induced Abortion Statistics*. The most recent data tables are available electronically at http://www.doh.wa.gov/EHSPHL/CHS/default.htm#Birth.

Limitations

This report includes limitations of small area analysis, differences in terminology, data completeness and accuracy of the primary administrative data.

<u>Small Area Analysis</u>. Rates may fluctuate from one year to another. Reporting in two- and five-year averages minimized this. Numbers and rates were suppressed when the number of events was less than five. Reporting rates for counties with low population levels, such as Garfield, is particularly problematic.

<u>Terminology</u>. The number of births reported includes all births, including those born dead. The Center for Health Statistics reports live births separately from fetal deaths. Caution should be taken when comparing Washington State birth rates to national rates. Our method is consistent with the age-adjusted birth rates calculated by the Washington State DOH-CHS.

<u>Completeness</u>. Some vital records are not available for research purposes, such as births that resulted in adoptions, and are not provided to the First Steps Database.

In *Pregnancy and Induced Abortion Statistics 1996*, DOH-CHS reported that the abortions for 1993-95 had been underreported and adjusted county abortion rates upward based on an overall estimate. The age-specific abortion rates in this report, which are based on unadjusted age-specific numbers, may underestimate the actual rates.

Population estimates are based on the most recent available intercensal and postcensal estimates of county population by age and sex. A discussion of factors affecting age and gender specific population estimates is available in *Forecast of the Population by Age and Sex, 1990 to 2020, November 1999 forecast*, at http://www.ofm.wa.gov/popagesex19702020/forecast99.pdf.

The basic statewide estimates of unintended pregnancy are based on annual data collected by the Department of Health on a sample of women who gave birth from April 1993 to December 1998. In using the PRAMS data, it was assumed that the data were accurately weighted to estimate the number of unintended pregnancies at a statewide level. Statewide data indicate that the proportion of unintended births varies depending on personal characteristics such as income, marital status, and age. In applying statewide rates of births from unintended pregnancies, county data were adjusted only for income distribution. The adjustment assumes that women with similar Medicaid status (Non-Medicaid, Other Medicaid, and Grant Recipients) have the same rates of unintended pregnancies in every county throughout the state.




Births from Unintended Pregnancy by Medicaid Status, 1993 to 1998

In Washington State an estimated 40% of births are unintended. The statewide rate has remained fairly constant since 1994, one year after this measure for unintended pregnancy became available. Overall, the rate has decreased modestly among lower income women, while slightly increasing among higher income women, who comprise the majority of Washington births. Medicaid eligibility was used as a proxy for income level.


Changes in the percent of births from unintended pregnancy for three different income levels are shown in the graph below for the six years of PRAMS data. Women with the lowest incomes (Grant Recipients) had the highest percent of births from unintended pregnancy. However, births from unintended pregnancy for these women decreased from 72.0% in 1993 to 57.7% in 1997. In 1998, this rate rose to 70.1%. Other low-income women covered by Medicaid but not eligible to receive cash grants (Other Medicaid) had rates that were intermediate between the lowest and the highest income women. Rates for the Other Medicaid group showed a steady decrease for all years, from 54.3% in 1993 to 45.6% in 1998. The highest income women, those who did not receive publicly funded medical care (Non-Medicaid), had the lowest percent of births from unintended pregnancy. The rate for this group increased slightly from 24.6% in 1994 to 28.1% in 1998.




Estimated Percent of Unintended Pregnancies, Including Abortions, by County (1994-98)




Estimated Percent of Births from Unintended Pregnancy by County (1994-98)

The proportion of Washington women who gave birth and had a subsequent birth within two years is presented by age group for three different time periods of births. Values represent the two year average of the proportion of women who gave birth during a given time period, and had a subsequent birth within two years.

The proportion of women who had a subsequent birth within two years has dropped over the time periods 1991-92 through 1995-96 for all age groups. This drop has occurred both for the overall population of Washington women and for the subgroup of women receiving grant assistance. The extent of this decrease among Washington women aged 15-39 ranged by age group from a 19.0% decrease in subsequent births for women aged 30-34, to a 30.2% decrease for those aged 15-17. Among Washington women aged 15-39 and receiving grant assistance at the time of their earlier birth, the decrease ranged from a 21.5% decrease in the proportion of subsequent births for women aged 18-19, to a 28.5% decrease for women aged 20-24.

Subsequent births tend to decrease as maternal age increases, since older women are more likely to have completed child-bearing.


