Subject of possible rule making: The department is planning to amend WAC 388-424-0001, "Citizenship and alien status – Definitions"; WAC 388-400-0010, "Who is eligible for state family assistance?"; WAC 388-424-0030, "How does my alien status impact my eligibility for state-funded benefits under the food assistance program?"; WAC 388-424-0010, "Citizenship and alien status – Eligibility for TANF"; WAC 388-424-0015, "Immigrant eligibility restrictions for the state family assistance, ABD cash and PWA programs"; WAC 388-424-0009, "Citizenship and alien status – Social Security number (SSN) requirements"; and other related rules as appropriate. The department is also planning to adopt a new section to chapter 388-490 WAC, "Verification."

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 74.04.050, RCW 74.04.055, RCW 74.04.057, and RCW 74.08.090

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Planned amendments are necessary to implement Third Substitute Senate Bill 5164, Chapter 136, Laws of 2020 which takes effect on February 1, 2022 and assists survivors of certain crimes.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: The Community Services Division (CSD) will coordinate review of proposed rulemaking with the Health Care Authority (HCA).
