Subject of possible rule making: The department is planning to amend WAC 388-478-0055, "How much do I get from my state supplemental payments (SSP)?" and other related rules as appropriate.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 74.04.050, 74.04.055, 74.04.057, 74.04.500, 74.04.510, 74.08.090, 74.08A.120, and 74.08A.250.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Federal law (C.F.R. 20 §416.2095 through §416.2099) requires the department to maintain a minimum threshold of state spending towards SSI state supplement payment benefits each calendar year in order to continue to draw down federal Medicaid funds. The department may propose modifying rules in order to stay within available state funds to support this spending requirement. As needed, planned amendments will make additional changes required to improve clarity, update policy, or better align rule language with state and federal law or regulations.
