WAC 388-106-0665 How are volunteers qualified to provide volunteer services? Volunteers are qualified to provide volunteer services through the following mechanisms:

- (1) Volunteers who will have unsupervised access to vulnerable adults cannot have any convictions, pending crimes or findings that are listed in WAC (($\frac{388-71-0105}{0}$)) $\frac{388-103-0001}{0}$ or provide contracted services per RCW 43.20A.0710 (1)(c) prior to working alone with them.
- (2) The volunteer services contractor(s) will provide orientation and ongoing training as needed to volunteers.
